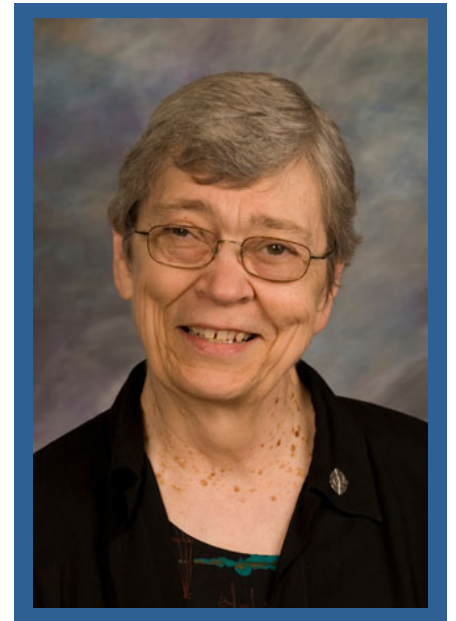

Sister Virginia served in elementary education and administration throughout the 1960s and '70s. These assignments took her to North Dakota, Washington, and Minnesota. Her longest role during this era was at St. Anne Grade School in Bismarck, North Dakota, from 1969-1974. From 1989 through 1997, she served at Our Lady of Good Counsel, Mankato, Minnesota, as Director of Development and Communications Director. Following a period of study and renewal, Sister Virginia continued in the field of development, sharing her gifts at Faithful Shepherd and Trinity Catholic Schools, as well as St. Paul Priory OSB, all in St. Paul. From 2011-2014, she served as a development volunteer at Chicago's Corazon a Corazon, a nonprofit serving the Latino community by providing language education and other assistance. Since 2014, Sister Virginia has devoted herself to congregational service at Our Lady of Good Counsel, Mankato, Minnesota. She holds a bachelor's degree in elementary education from Mount Mary College in Milwaukee, and later earned a master's degree in elementary administration from Gonzaga University in Spokane.
