Sister M. Vianney Saumweber, SSND

Sister M. Vianney began her ministry in her hometown of St. Paul with a degree in education. Her earliest roles were as a grade school teacher at St. Matthew in St. Paul, from 1949-1954. She continued teaching elementary grades through 1970, with assignments including: Silver Lake Catholic Schools, St. Joseph in Red Wing, and St. John Catechetical School in Minnesota Lake. During the early 1970s, she cared for an ailing family at home in St. Paul, while teaching part-time at Sacred Heart Grade School. From 1973-1980, she taught at St. Matthew in St. Paul, and also served there in pastoral ministry. Sister M. Vianney answered a new call in 1990, serving in pastoral ministry to residents at St. Anne Hospice in Winona through 1996. Turning to congregational service, she assisted at Our Lady of Good Counsel in Mankato through 1999, then worked as a driver for five years at St. Francis de Sales in St. Paul, continuing there in prayerful service to the congregation through 2009. Since that time, Sister M. Vianney has resided in prayer and presence at Our Lady of Good Counsel.
