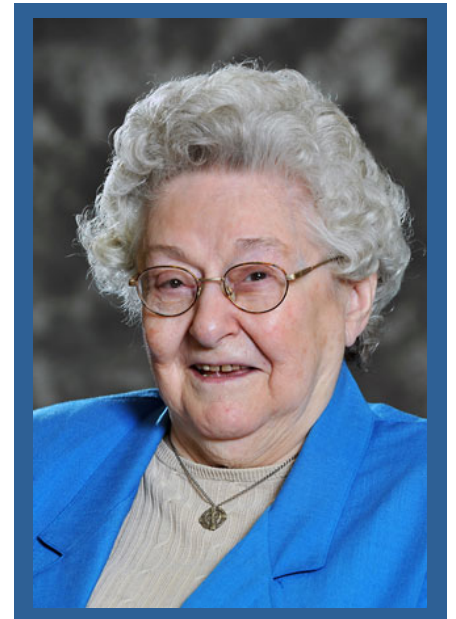

## **Sister Mary Angeleen Brill, SSND**

*Sister Mary Angeleen's earliest ministry decades were devoted to teaching in Catholic grade schools in Chicago. Each of her first two assignments, at St. Paul and St. Alphonsus, lasted nearly a decade. From 1964-1976, she taught elementary age students at St. John Nepomucene in Prairie du Chien, Wisconsin. Sister Mary Angeleen moved to the Milwaukee area, serving the schools of St. George in Kenosha; St. Mary in Port Washington; and St. Mary in Elm Grove (as a tutor) through the dawn of the new millennium. She served in volunteer ministries at Notre Dame of Elm Grove from 1996-2004, and continues to reside there in prayerful presence. Sister Mary Angeleen holds a bachelor's degree in education from Mount Mary College in Milwaukee. In 1971, she earned a master's degree in elementary education from DePaul University in Chicago.*
