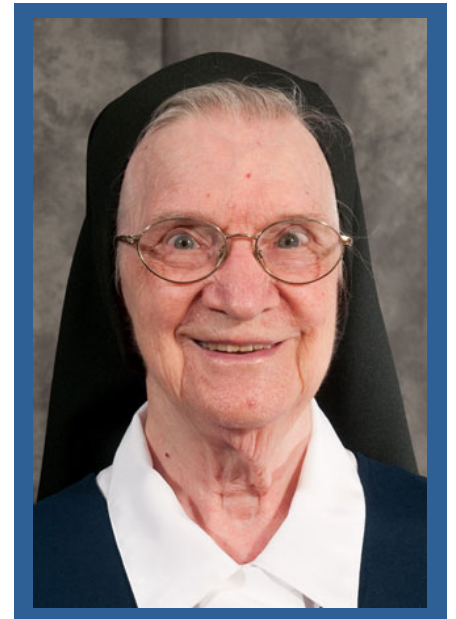

Sister Marie Virginia Strubhart, SSND

Sister Marie Virginia served the majority of her active ministry in teaching and administration at Catholic grade schools. Beginning in 1943, she taught for three years at Sacred Heart in her home diocese of Belleville, Illinois. Moving to the St. Louis region, she taught at St. Charles Borromeo from 1946-1950, followed by brief assignments in Little Rock, Arkansas, and Rich Fountain, Missouri. Sister Marie Virginia followed her call to California. From 1955-1964, she taught and served in administration at St. Helen in Fresno and Our Lady of Perpetual Help in Indio. Coming back home to the Belleville area, she continued in teaching and administration at the schools of: St. Luke, St. Augustine, St. Michael, and St. Dominic. Her final teaching assignment, from 1986-1992, was spent at Our Lady Queen of Peace in House Springs near St. Louis. Sister Marie Virginia then moved to Sancta Maria in Ripa in St. Louis, serving the next decade in liturgical fabric arts and the campus post office. She held various other roles serving the congregation through 2011, and currently resides in prayerful presence at Veronica House in Bridgeton. Sister Marie Virginia earned a bachelor's degree in elementary education from Arkansas State University. She holds a master's degree in elementary administration from St. Louis University.
