Sister M. Yvonne Nohava, SSND

Sister M. Yvonne devoted her active full-time ministry to teaching and administration at Catholic grade schools and high schools across the dioceses of Winona and St. Paul/Minneapolis, Minnesota. She began in 1939 at St. Michael, followed by four years at St. Stanislaus in St. Paul. Moving to administration, she served six years at St. John Nepomucene in Winona, followed by six years at St. John in Mankato. From 1958-1989, Sister M. Yvonne returned to the classroom, serving at the high schools of: St. Michael in St. Michael; Loyola and Our Lady of Good Counsel Academy in Mankato; and St. Agnes in St. Paul. Over the next decade and leading up to the dawn of the new millennium, Sister M. Yvonne served as a tutor at Good Counsel Learning Center. She devoted the early 2000s to congregational services at Our Lady of Good Counsel and continues to reside there in prayerful presence. She holds a bachelor's degree in chemistry from Mount Mary College in Milwaukee. In 1954, she earned a master's degree in education-chemistry from Creighton University in Omaha, Nebraska.
