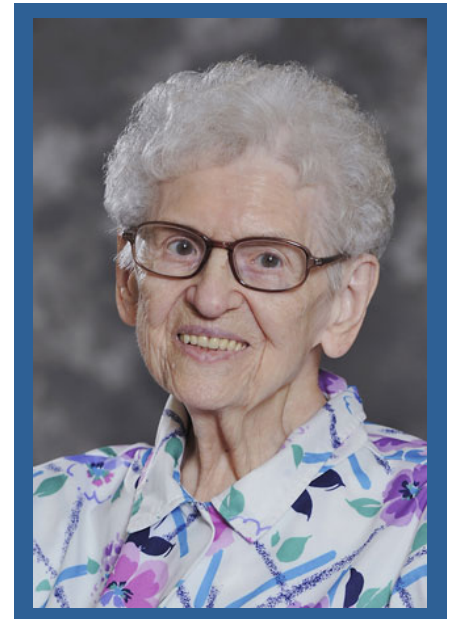

*Sister Mercita taught primary students far more than 40 years. In Wisconsin, her missions included: St. Francis Xavier in DePere, St. Francis Xavier in Green Bay, St. Agnes in Butler, Holy Cross/Consolidation in Mount Calvary, St. Mary in Menasha and St. Gabriel in Prairie du Chien. Additionally, she taught at St. Margaret of Scotland in Chicago and in Michigan at St. Adalbert, St. Isidore, St. Mary in Grand Rapids and Eastside Vicariate Elementary in Detroit. She received a bachelor's in education and sociology from Mount Mary College in Milwaukee and a bachelor's in theology from St. Joseph College in Rensselaer, Indiana. When she left full-time teaching in 1986, she continued to tutor and serve in volunteer ministry. Sister Mary Mercita retired in 1997, joining the Notre Dame of Elm Grove community where she serves through prayer and presence.*
