*Born in Marquette, Michigan, **Sister Annette Marie** Johnson entered the SSND novitiate in Mequon, Wisconsin, in 1968. She taught middle school students throughout the 1970s, serving at the Wisconsin grade schools of St. Stephen in Stevens Point, St. Francis Xavier in Superior, and St. John Baptist in Marshfield. Sister Annette devoted the next 12 years of ministry as a director of religious education. Those assignments took her to St. Peter in Marquette, Michigan, Sacred Hearts of Jesus & Mary in Sun Prairie, Wisconsin, and St. Gregory in Newberry, Michigan. She was called to be a pastoral associate at St. Mary Parish in Custer, Wisconsin, where she served from 1992 - 2000. Following four years as director of religious education for St. Paul parish in Negaunee, Michigan, Sister Annette served as full-time hospital chaplain at St. Elizabeth Hospital in Appleton, Wisconsin, as a Board Certified Chaplain. She holds a bachelor's degree in elementary education from the University of Wisconsin-Stevens Point and a master's in religious education from Aquinas College in Grand Rapids, Michigan.*
