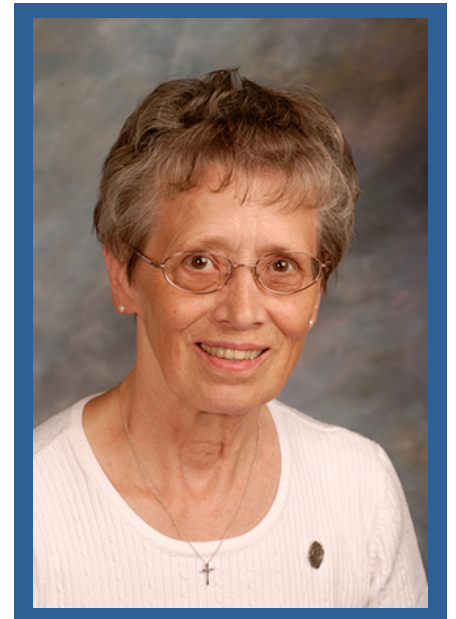

Sister Francette Malecha entered the SSND novitiate in Mankato, Minnesota, in 1959. Her earliest ministries were devoted to serving the congregation in housekeeping and food services. Those assignments included posts at Our Lady of Good Counsel and the Good Counsel Academy at Our Lady Good Counsel in Mankato, Minnesota. In 1974, Sister Francette turned her attention to ministries helping children in and around St. Paul/Minneapolis. From 1976-1981, she worked in administration for New Horizons Child Care, followed by 14 years in administration at Sandcastle Child Care Center in St. Paul, Minnesota. Since 1995, Sister Francette has served as a care provider at Li'l Farm Children's Home in Cambridge, Minnesota. She holds a bachelor's degree in early childhood education from the Metro State University-St. Paul.
