Sister Jane Marie Kulczak, SSND

Sister Jane Marie Kulczak entered the SSND novitiate in 1958 in Milwaukee. She devoted her earliest ministry decades to teaching Catholic grade school students around the Midwest. Earliest assignments took her to St. Joachim in Chicago and St. Stanislaus in Michigan City, Indiana. From 1966-1975, she taught in her hometown of Grand Rapids, Michigan, at St. James. Following several shorter assignments, she returned to Grand Rapids, Michigan, in 1979, teaching at Sacred Heart through 1984. Sister Jane Marie followed her call to Elm Grove, Wisconsin, where she spent six years serving as a receptionist at Notre Dame Health Care Center. Her final decade of full-time ministry coincided with the end of 2000; back home at Sacred Heart, she served on staff as librarian, aide, and clerical assistant. Sister Jane Marie continued to volunteer in the early 2000s and lived for a time at Our Lady of Mount Carmel in Mount Calvary, Wisconsin. She now resides in prayerful presence at Our Lady of the Angels in Greenfield, Wisconsin. Sister Jane Marie graduated with a bachelor's of philosophy degree in sociology from the former Mount Mary College in Milwaukee.
