Sister Mary Caroline Jakubowski, SSND

Born in Milwaukee, Sister Mary Caroline Jakubowski entered the SSND novitiate in Mequon, Wisconsin, in 1958. After her first profession of vows, she served one year as an elementary school teacher at St. Mary in Burlington, Wisconsin, followed by six years at St. Vincent de Paul in Milwaukee. From 1968-1970, she served at Caroline Academy in Mequon, Wisconsin, followed by three vears in administration at St. Agnes in Butler, Wisconsin. Sister Mary Caroline was called to congregational leadership and served as provincial councilor at Notre Dame of the Lake in Mequon, Wisconsin, for the next six years. Following four years in agency administration serving homeless women, she devoted an additional eight years in province leadership in Milwaukee. Sister Mary Caroline relocated to Chicago, serving Catholic Charities as a caseworker from 1993-2003. Throughout the next decade, she operated Caroline Design in Park City near Chicago, serving in graphic design. In 2013, she returned to Wisconsin to serve as a community leader at Our Lady of the Angels residence in Greenfield, Wisconsin. From her parents' home, she continues to volunteer and minister in prayerful presence. Sister Mary Caroline earned a bachelor's degree in art from



the former Mount Mary College in Milwaukee. She holds a master's degree in counseling/guidance from Loras College in Dubuque, Iowa.
