Sister Patricia Marie Lange made her first profession in St. Louis in 1959. She devoted her entire ministry to teaching Catholic middle school students around the St. Louis area. Her earliest assignments took her to seven St. Louis schools in 14 years, including: St. Barbara, St. Francis de Sales and St. Aloysius Gonzaga. Her final 35 years in full-time ministry were at two schools: Our Lady of Sorrows in South St. Louis, Missouri, from 1975-1986 and St. Joseph in Manchester, Missouri, from 1986-2009. Sister Patricia Marie continues tutoring elementary students and serves as catechist at St. Gerard Majella in Des Peres, Missouri. She earned a bachelor's degree in history from the former Notre Dame College in St. Louis. In 1976, she graduated with a master's degree in education from Southeast Missouri State University in Cape Girardeau, Missouri.
