Born in Fort Madison, Iowa, *Sister Phyllis Ann Price* entered SSND in St. Louis. She served her first 12 years of ministry in her home diocese of Davenport, Iowa, teaching Catholic grade school students at St. Mary in Keokuk, St. Anthony in Knoxville and St. John in Burlington. From 1973-1978, Sister Phyllis Ann served as an elementary school consultant for the Diocese of Davenport. She answered a call to teach at St. Gertrude in Krakow, Missouri, for two years. Beginning in 1980, she served for 16 years as administrator of Notre Dame Preschool in St. Louis. She left this ministry to be an in-home family child caretaker for a period of four years, fulfilling a desire to care for very young children in their homes. Following this, she assisted in the art department and in the development office at Notre Dame High School in St. Louis through 2006. For the next 11 years, Sister Phyllis Ann ministered in pastoral care at Mercy Hospital in St. Louis. She continues to volunteer with young children and the elderly in the St. Louis area, where she resides. She holds a bachelor's degree in history from the former Notre Dame College in St. Louis. In 1975, she graduated with a master's degree in elementary education from Southern Illinois University-Edwardsville.
