## Sister Rose Daily, SSND

*Sister Rose Daily was born near St. Louis and made her first profession at Sancta Maria in Ripa in St. Louis, in 1959. Her first decade of ministry was devoted to teaching around the Midwest as she served Catholic elementary school students across three dioceses of Missouri during the 1960s. Sister Rose turned to pastoral ministry in 1972, serving at St. Boniface in Quincy, Illinois, through 1976, followed by five years' service at the SSND Villa Gesu retirement home in St. Louis. She continued in pastoral ministries across Missouri through 1989, devoting herself to parishioners at Sacred Heart and St. Brendan in the Jefferson City diocese, as well as St. Francis Xavier in Springfield-Cape Girardeau. Following a period of missionary teaching and other pastoral ministries in Sierra Leone and Mexico, Sister Rose returned to St. Louis in 1996. She served in Hispanic ministry at Southside Catholic Community School from 1996-2002. From 2002–2015, she served as a full-time chaplain at Mercy Hospital (the former St. John's Mercy) in St. Louis. Today, she continues to volunteer there, as well as at St. Patrick Center in downtown St. Louis. Sister Rose holds a bachelor's degree in biology from the former Notre Dame College in St. Louis. In 1984, she earned a master's degree in theology from the University of Steubenville in Ohio.*
