Sister Therese Marie Everts, SSND

Sister Therese Marie Everts was born in Wisconsin and made her first profession of SSND vows at Mequon in 1959. She spent the better part of her early ministry as a teacher and administrator in Catholic elementary schools around the diocese of Milwaukee including: St. Elizabeth in Milwaukee; Holy Assumption in West Allis; St. Joseph in Wauwatosa; and St. Stephen in Milwaukee. In 1973, she accepted a leadership post as Provincial Councilor in Mequon, Wisconsin, serving at Notre Dame of the Lake through 1983. Sister Therese Marie worked in administration and campus ministry at Mount Mary University in the mid-1980s. Beginning in 1987, she answered a call to serve in formation services in Germany. Following two years in Westfalea in the diocese of Koeln, Germany, she moved to Brakel, Germany. There, she served in Provincial leadership in the provincial house Brede from 1989-2003, ministering in concurrent services as director of initial formation and in spiritual direction. She returned to Milwaukee in 2012, undertaking numerous volunteer ministries. She currently resides in prayerful presence at Our Lady of the Angels in Greenfield, Wisconsin. She holds both a bachelor's and master's degree in English, from former Mount Mary College in Milwaukee and Marquette University, respectively.
