## Sister Agnes Therese Hastreiter, SSND

*Sister Agnes Therese Hastreiter made her first profession in 1949 in Milwaukee. She devoted the majority of her active ministry as a teacher, serving across Wisconsin. Her longest assignments included: St. Mary Grade School in De Pere from 1949-1960; St. Peter in Beaver Dam from 1963-1974; and St. Joseph in Wauwatosa from 1975 - 1980. Sister Agnes Therese had additional ministries throughout the 1980s and 1990s, including consultant and cosmetology roles for the congregation. Her years of prayer ministry and community service has been served at SSND's Milwaukee Residence in Notre Dame of Elm Grove, Wisconsin. She currently resides at Greenfield's Our Lady of the Angels in Wisconsin. Sister Agnes Therese holds a bachelor's degree in education from St. Norbert College in De Pere, Wisconsin. In 1974, she earned a master's degree in reading education from Cardinal Stritch University in Milwaukee.*
