## Sister Anthony Marie Kasper, SSND

Born and raised in St. Louis, *Sister Anthony Marie Kasper* made her first profession there in 1949. Early teaching assignments took her to the Illinois schools of St. Joseph in East St. Louis, Sacred Heart in DuQuoin, and St. Luke in Belleville. From 1953-1961, she served at St. Peter in St. Charles, Missouri. Sister Anthony Marie continued in classroom teaching and administration at St. Anthony's in Sullivan, Missouri, then nine years at St. Francis Borgia in Washington, Missouri. Following two years of teaching at St. Stephen in Caseyville, Illinois, she came home to St. Louis in 1984, devoting her ministry to the students and parishioners of Our Lady of Sorrows for well over 25 years. She now resides in prayerful presence at Sancta Maria in Ripa in St. Louis. Sister Anthony Marie earned a bachelor's and master's degree in elementary education, the first from the former Notre Dame College in St. Louis and the latter from St. Louis University.
