Sister Arline Jaeger, SSND

Sister Arline Jaeger was born in Milwaukee and made her first profession there in 1949. She served for 40 years as a teacher, musician, and administrator in schools across Wisconsin. Early assignments took her to Holy Trinity in Milwaukee, Holy Redeemer in Madison, St. Aloysius in Arcadia, Wisconsin, Holy Cross in Milwaukee, and Holy Assumption in West Allis, Wisconsin. From 1973-1983, Sister Arline devoted herself to teaching and administration at Mary Queen of Heaven in West Allis, Wisconsin, followed by two years at Christ the King in Wauwatosa, Wisconsin. During the late 1980s and through the early 2000s, she cared for family members in her Milwaukee home, while working on staff at the Tyme Out Retreat Center in Pewaukee, Wisconsin. In the years since, Sister Arline has volunteered as a tutor for the Milwaukee Achiever Literacy Services and resided in prayerful presence at Notre Dame of Elm Grove, Wisconsin. She earned a bachelor's degree in education from the former Mount Mary College in Milwaukee. She later completed a master's degree in elementary education administration at the University of Wisconsin.
