Sister Dorothy Cherrier, SSND

Sister Dorothy (Mary Roy) Cherrier made her first profession in Milwaukee and devoted the first 27 years of her ministry to teaching. She served elementary students at All Saints in Chicago throughout the 1950s. Throughout the next 15 years, she taught at St. Joseph in Milwaukee, McDonnell Central High in Chippewa Falls, Wisconsin, and Marinette Catholic Central High in the Green Bay diocese. Sister Dorothy cared for her aging mother for several years in Prairie du Chien, Wisconsin, then resumed her ministry with the provincial office in Milwaukee as an administrative assistant from 1983 – 1991. She traveled to Rome, serving seven years in administration at the SSND Generalate before returning to Elm Grove, Wisconsin, near the end of the 2000s. From 2002-2006, Sister Dorothy served as a provincial secretary in Dallas. Since then, she has served as a full-time receptionist at the SSND provincial offices in Elm Grove, Wisconsin. She earned a bachelor's degree in French from the former Mount Mary College in Milwaukee.
