## Sister Mary Dominic Klaseus, SSND

*Sister Mary Dominic Klaseus was born in Mankato, Minnesota, and made her first profession there in 1949. Her many decades of ministry have been devoted largely to teaching Catholic middle school students and elementary administration. Early assignments across Minnesota included: Holy Childhood in St. Paul, St. Felix in Wabasha, St. Mary in Worthington, and Sacred Heart in St. Paul. From 1965-1977, she served in administration at two Mankato, Minnesota, schools: St. John and Fitzgerald Middle School. During the next decade, Sister Mary Dominic served in administration at Lonsdale-New Mark-Veseli in Lonsdale, Minnesota. She continued in a similar role at St. Timothy in Maple Lake, Minnesota, through 1993. During the mid-1990s through the 2000s, she worked as administrator of St. Joseph Hall at Our Lady of Good Counsel in Mankato, Minnesota, continuing there in several roles in hospitality and volunteer coordination through 2017. Sister Mary Dominic continues to volunteer and serve in prayerful presence. She completed a bachelor's degree in English at the College of St. Catherine in St. Paul, Minnesota. She later earned two masters' degrees in education administration from the former Mankato State University, Minnesota.*
