## Sister Mary Josephe Misevicz, SSND

*Sister Mary Josephe Misevicz hails from Berlin, Wisconsin, and made her first profession in Milwaukee in 1944. She devoted decades of ministry as a Catholic kindergarten and elementary school teacher around the Milwaukee area. From 1944-1956, she served at St. Casimir, followed by two years at Sts. Cyril and Methodius. Following two years at Holy Rosary in Chicago, Sister Mary Josephe return to Milwaukee, teaching at St. Mary in Elm Grove, Wisconsin, and St. George in Kenosha, Wisconsin, the latter assignment concluding in 1975. From 1975-1986, she ministered as a resource staff assistant at Holy Cross/Consolidation grade school in Mount Calvary, Wisconsin. From 1986-2012, she lived in prayerful ministry at Our Lady of Mount Carmel, Wisconsin. Sister Mary Josephe currently resides at Notre Dame of Elm Grove, Elm Grove, Wisconsin. She holds a bachelor's degree in education from the former Mount Mary College in Milwaukee.*
