## Sister Mary Frederick Keller, SSND

*Born in Belleville, Illinois, **Sister Mary Frederick** Keller made her first profession in St. Louis in 1938. Her earliest ministry decades were devoted to teaching Catholic high school students around the Midwest, including: Rosati-Kain in St. Louis; Academy of Notre Dame in Belleville, Illinois; St. Peter in St. Charles, Missouri; and Notre Dame in Quincy, Illinois. From 1952-1960, Sister Mary Frederick taught at St. Mary's in Cape Girardeau, Missouri. She then returned to St. Louis, spending the next 11 years with the secondary students at Notre Dame High School. From 1971-1983, she served in congregational services, at Villa Gesu retirement home in St. Louis, and on staff at the former Notre Dame College and Notre Dame High School in secretarial and finance roles. She continued in similar roles at Notre Dame High School in Quincy, Illinois, concluding her service there in 1995. Sister Mary Frederick came home to St. Louis. She served 11 years on staff at the Notre Dame Tutorial Center and SSND offices. Since 2006, she has resided in prayerful presence at the Sarah Community in Bridgeton, Missouri. She holds three degrees from St. Louis University; a bachelor's degree in chemistry, and masters' in secondary education and physics.*
