### Sister Carol Jean Nishke, SSND

*Sister Carol was born in East St. Louis, Illinois. She made her first profession in St. Louis in 1960. Her first decade of ministry took her to classrooms across Missouri and Illinois, her longest assignment was five years at St. Joseph in Manchester, Missouri. Between 1962 and 1973, she also taught in Illinois at St. Francis Solanus. She then went to St. Liborius, St. Barbara, and St. Engelbert, all in St. Louis. She continued at St. Engelbert in administration through 1980. Sister Carol worked at St. Stephen in Caseyville, Illinois, throughout the early 1980s, then turned to pastoral service. She served at St. Augustine parish in North Little Rock, Arkansas, from 1984 through 1989. She then accepted a position in preschool education, serving for the next 20 years as executive director of the St. Augustine Center for Children, North Little Rock, Arkansas. Since 2009, Sister Carol has served the congregation as an associate archivist, directing the preservation of SSND heritage at St. Mary of the Pines in Chatawa, Mississippi, where she resided until 2019. She now lives at St. Anthony's Gardens in Covington, Louisiana. In 1962, she earned a bachelor's degree in music theory from the former Notre Dame College in St. Louis.*
