Sister Marianne Siegel, SSND

Sister Marianne was born in Sheboygan, Wisconsin. She made her first profession at Notre Dame of the Lake, Mequon, Wisconsin, in 1960. Her decades of ministry have centered on roles in teaching and finance. Following one year of teaching at St. Adalbert in Grand Rapids, Michigan, Sister Marianne accepted assignments at several schools across Wisconsin: St. Michael in Milwaukee from 1963 through 1964; St. Mary in Burlington, from 1964 to 1965 and Lourdes High School in Oshkosh from 1965 through 1966. She served the congregation as assistant treasurer for two years at Notre Dame of the Lake in Mequon, Wisconsin. From 1972 to 1983, Sister Marianne worked as an accounting clerk for Milwaukee's Marine Bank, followed by seven years in a similar role at St. Mary's Hospital in Milwaukee. Later ministries in Milwaukee included; accounting clerk at Wisconsin Paper Company from 1991 through 1994; accounts receivable associate at Mount Mary College (now University) from 1994 to 2003; and a similar role at Marian Franciscan Center from 2003 through 2008. For the next five years, she worked as a cashier/biller for Lutheran Home for the Aging in Wauwatosa, Wisconsin. Sister Marianne currently serves as a volunteer at her parish at St. Jude the Apostle Parish in Wauwatosa, Wisconsin, and in finance at Notre Dame of Elm Grove, Elm Grove, Wisconsin. She holds a bachelor's degree in business education from Mount Mary College (now University) in Milwaukee.
