### Sister Rose Mary Snaza, SSND

*Sister Rose Mary was born in Webster, South Dakota. She made her first profession in 1960 in Mankato, Minnesota. Her ministry has included roles as a middle/high school teacher and treasurer. Early assignments in Minnesota included: St. Stanislaus, Winona, 1961 to 1966; St. Casimir, Wells, 1966 to 1968; St. Mary, Shakopee, 1968 to 1970; Shakopee Area Catholic Schools, 1970 to 1971; and Loyola High School, Mankato, 1971 to 1979. Sister Rose Mary moved to Iowa, teaching two years at Don Bosco High School in Gilbertville before returning to Minnesota, where she spent two years at Lourdes in Rochester. From 1983 through 1989, she worked as assistant treasurer for the congregation's Generalate in Rome. Sister Rose Mary returned to classroom teaching during the 1990s at Loyola in Mankato and DeLaSalle in Minneapolis. In 2000, she accepted a post as the former province of Mankato treasurer while residing at Our Lady of Good Counsel (OLGC) in Mankato. Since 2011, Sister Rose Mary has served the Central Pacific province as assistant treasurer. She holds a bachelor's degree in elementary education from Mount Mary College (now University) in Milwaukee and a master's degree in mathematics from Boston College.*
