### Sister Toni Marie Jendrasiak, SSND

*Sister Toni Marie was born in Grand Rapids, Michigan. She made her first profession at Notre Dame of the Lake, Mequon, Wisconsin, in 1960. Following her first two-year teaching assignment at St. John Kanty in Milwaukee, she taught at SS. Peter & Paul in Gary, Indiana, from 1964 through 1971. Sister Toni Marie relocated to Huntington, Indiana, serving students at SS. Peter & Paul for two years. She came home to Grand Rapids, teaching at Sacred Heart through 1979, then at St. James through 1983. Turning to religious education, she worked at St. Cecilia Parish in Clare, Michigan, for the next eight years, followed by a similar role at Our Lady of Ransom in Niles, Illinois. From 1996 to 2000, Sister Toni Marie served as a pastoral associate at the parish of Sacred Heart in Manawa, Wisconsin. She continued in a similar role at St. Joseph in Green Bay. When St. Joseph was linked with three other parishes, she served them all through elder care from 2006 through 2015. Sister Toni Marie continues to volunteer for them. In 1966, she completed a bachelor's degree in history at Mount Mary College (now University) in Milwaukee. Later, she earned masters' degrees in reading education and pastoral ministry, at St. Francis College in Fort Wayne, Indiana, and Loyola University of Chicago, Illinois, respectively.*
