Sister Betty was born in Cape Girardeau, Missouri, and in 1971, made her first profession in St. Louis. In 1972, she received a bachelor's degree in American studies from the former Notre Dame College, St. Louis. She began her teaching ministry at St. Joseph, Cairo, Illinois, where she taught from 1972 to 1974. After this period, she spent the next 29 years teaching in Missouri schools, including St. Bridget, Pacific; Holy Family, Freeburg; St. Joseph, Westphalia; Visitation Interparish, Vienna; and All Saints, St. Peters. She also served as administrator for Holy Family from 1983 to 1987; St. Joseph from 1991 to 1994; and Visitation Interparish from 1994 to 2000. During this period, she earned two master's degrees from Clarke College (now University) in Dubuque, Iowa, the first in reading education and the second in elementary education administration. Sister Betty currently serves as community care coordinator for Anna House at The Sarah Community, Bridgeton, Missouri.
