Sister Christine served as a boarders directress for three years at Notre Dame Girls' Secondary School, Kyoto, and for one year, as a staff member caring for the aged and sick at the Iwakura Convent, Kyoto. During the 2000s, she was a member of the community service staff at the Generalate in Rome. Sister Christine now is a part-time volunteer at a day care serving elderly and disabled people.
