Sister Gloria Cain, SSND

Sister Gloria was born in New Orleans and in 1961 made first profession in St. Louis. She received a bachelor's degree in American studies from the former Notre Dame College, St. Louis, in 1963. Sister Gloria spent her early ministry years teaching at Our Lady of Fatima, Galena Park, Texas; San Jose, Albuquerque, New Mexico; St. Paul, Fort Worth, Texas; St. Gerard Majella, Baton Rouge, Louisiana; and Our Lady Queen of Heaven, Lake Charles, Louisiana. In 1973, she was named principal at Our Lady Queen of Heaven where she remained until 1983. During that time, she received a master's degree in administration and supervision from Our Lady of the Lake University, San Antonio. Sister Gloria then served as associate superintendent and director of spiritual renewal for lay organizations for the Diocese of Lake Charles, Louisiana. She was named the first superintendent for the diocese in 1985, serving in that capacity for 11 years. She went to Texas in 1996, serving as the first superintendent for the Diocese of Victoria and then in 2008, as superintendent for the Diocese of Dallas. After retiring as superintendent in 2015, and at the request of the bishop, she served for one year as the bishop's delegate for mission effectiveness for the Diocese of Dallas. Sister Gloria is currently at Notre Dame of Dallas, serving as a sister donor representative for the SSND Central Pacific Province.
