## Sister Linda Jansen, SSND

Sister Linda was born in Breese, Illinois, and in 1961, made first profession in St. Louis. In 1963, she received a bachelor's degree in economics from the former Notre Dame College, St. Louis. After receiving her degree, Sister Linda taught for nine years at St. Francis Borgia in Washington, Missouri, and became administrator there in 1970. In 1972, she received a master's degree in business education from the State College of Arkansas, Conway, Arkansas. She received a second master's degree in administration from Southeast Missouri State University, Cape Girardeau, in 1974. After serving at St. Francis Borgia until 1976, Sister Linda went to Duchesne High School, St. Charles, Missouri. She taught there from 1976 to 1977, and then served as administrator from 1977 to 1979. Beginning in 1979, Sister Linda served eight years as secretary for the former St. Louis province. In 1987, she returned to St. Francis Borgia, teaching business education there until 2001. She served as treasurer for the former St. Louis province until 2011, and then as assistant treasurer for the new Central Pacific Province at Sancta Maria in Ripa, St. Louis, until 2016. Recently, Sister Linda engaged in volunteer work with the finance department and the Resource Development office at Sancta Maria in Ripa.
