## Sister Mary Genevieve Sato, SSND

*Sister Mary Genevieve was born in Kyoto, Japan, and made first profession in 1961 at Shishigatani Convent, Kyoto. For more than 30 years as a woman religious, she supported children and youth at six parish churches in the Japanese dioceses of Kyoto, Nagoya and Naha. As a licensed cook, she served in the kitchen at Notre Dame Elementary School, Tokyo, preparing lunches for students from 1968 to 1973. From 1982 to 1985, she served at the Kyoto Catechetical Center. Starting in 1998, Sister Mary Genevieve served as the assistant student residence director at Notre Dame Women's College, Kyoto, until 2001. She provided cooking and cleaning services at different communities including Shishigatani and Matsugasaki Convents, both in Kyoto. Mary Genevieve is currently engaged in community service at Kotakeyabu-cho Convent, Kyoto.*
