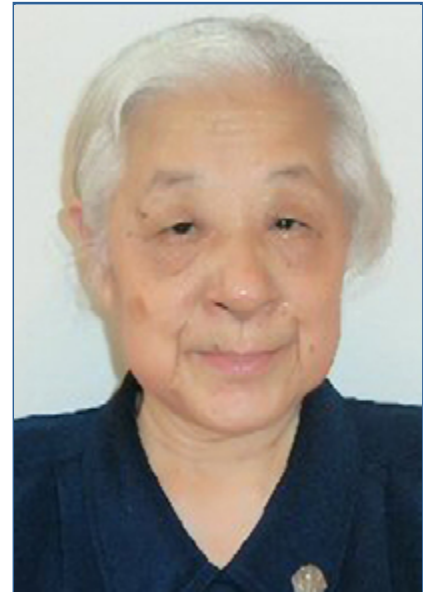
First Profession—4/7/1961
