Sister Marjorie was born on her family's farm near Meriden, Minnesota, and in 1951, made first profession in Mankato, Minnesota. In that same year, she began her ministry teaching at St. Joseph, Spokane, Washington. She taught at St. Joseph for two years and then returned to the Midwest where she taught at Holy Rosary, North Mankato; Crucifixion, LaCrescent; Immaculate Conception, Gilbertville, Iowa; and St. Felix, Wabasha. During this time, Sister Marjorie received a bachelor's degree in education from Mount Mary College (now University), Milwaukee, and a master's degree in counseling and guidance from Loras College, Dubuque, Iowa. From 1972 to 1973, she served as administrator at St. Mary, Worthington, Minnesota. She then returned to the classroom, teaching at Epiphany, Coon Rapids; St. Felix, Wabasha; St. Wenceslaus, New Prague; and St. Michael, St. Michael, all in Minnesota. From 1995 to 2000, she continued to serve at St. Michael as a reading specialist and a teacher's aide. She provided care to the aged and infirm through Sisters Care, St. Paul, Minnesota, from 2001 to 2007, and provided home health care from 2007 to 2008 through Abbey Care Choice, St. Paul. Sister Marjorie now serves in prayer and presence at Our Lady of Good Counsel, Mankato.
