She also served for one year in housekeeping at St. Pius, St. Pius, North Dakota. In the late 1980s, Sister Mary Owen ministered to the elderly at Cedar Haven Apartments, Mankato, and since 2007, has resided in community service, prayer and presence at Our Lady of Good Counsel.
