## Sister Rochelle Trembley, SSND

Sister Rochelle was born in Winnebago, Minnesota, and made first profession in 1951 in Mankato, Minnesota. She began her ministry that same year teaching in Minnesota schools, including St. Mary, Shakopee; Crucifixion, LaCrescent; and St. John the Baptist, Dayton. In 1954, she went to Washington, teaching at Guardian Angel, Colton, and Holy Family, Clarkston. In 1962, she earned her bachelor's degree in education from Mount Mary College (now University), Milwaukee. From 1964 to 1965, she taught at Trinity High School, Dickinson, North Dakota, before returning to Minnesota. She ministered in the St. Paul area from 1965 to 1985, teaching at St. Matthew, St. Francis de Sales and St. Agnes. Sister Rochelle remained at St. Agnes in community service until 1988 before serving the community at Our Lady of Good Counsel, Mankato. She currently resides in prayer and presence at Our Lady of Good Counsel.
