## Sister Noel Ewald, SSND

*Sister Noel was born in Adams, Minnesota, and in 1946, made first profession in Mankato, Minnesota. From 1946 to 1955, she served in homemaking and housekeeping at St. Leo Catechetical School, Pipestone, Minnesota; Our Lady of Good Counsel, Mankato; SS. Peter and Paul, Mantador, North Dakota; and St. Bernard, Cologne, Minnesota. Beginning in the mid-1950s, she taught in schools throughout Minnesota and Iowa including St. Francis de Sales, St. Paul; St. Michael, Morgan; Blessed Sacrament, Waterloo; St. Peter and Paul, Loretto; St. Casimir, Winona; St. Stanislaus, Winona; St. Felix, Wabasha; and St. Michael, St. Michael. In 1973, Sister Noel received a bachelor's degree in elementary education from Mount Mary College (now University), Milwaukee. After receiving her degree, she taught elementary school students at St. Anne, Bismarck, North Dakota; and Crucifixion, La Crescent, Minnesota. After a sabbatical, Sister Noel served as a librarian at St. Mark, Shakopee, Minnesota, from 1977 to 1981. During the 1980s and part of the 1990s, she was engaged in community service at Our Lady of Good Counsel and ministered to the elderly through Sisters Care, St. Paul. Since 1997, Sister Noel has been serving in prayer and presence at Our Lady of Good Counsel.*
