## Sister Anne Francioni, SSND

*First Profession - July 13, 1997 | Celebrating 25 Years*



**Sister Anne Francioni** is a native of New Orleans and in the late 1970s first felt the call to become a School Sister of Notre Dame (SSND) when she worked with SSND while teaching at St. Michael Special School, New Orleans and while serving as a dormitory mother and director of childcare and nursing at St. Mary Special School, St. Louis. In 1980 she received a registered nursing diploma from Touro Infirmary School of Nursing, New Orleans. She then received a bachelor's degree in special education from the University of Missouri-St. Louis in 1991 and a master's degree in management from Webster University, Webster Groves, Missouri, in 1993. In 1997 Sister Anne professed first vows in St. Louis. She has served as a staff nurse at Touro Infirmary and Children's Hospital, New Orleans; and at Cardinal Glennon Children's Hospital, St. Louis Children's Hospital and Nurses for Newborns, all in St. Louis. In 1999 she founded Whole Kids Outreach, an organization located in Ellington, Missouri, that serves pregnant women/teens and families in 11 impoverished counties of the Missouri Ozarks. She continues to serve as the organization's executive director.
