Sister Ann Scholz is originally from Quincy, Illinois, and in 1972 she professed first vows in St. Louis. In 1973 she received a bachelor's degree in history from the former Notre Dame College, St. Louis. During the early years of her ministry, Sister Ann taught at Notre Dame High School, Burlington, Iowa; Helias High School, Jefferson City, Missouri; and Notre Dame High School, St. Louis. In 1983 she began her studies at American University, Washington, D.C., receiving a master's degree in international education in 1984 and a doctorate in international education in 1991. From 1991 to 2002 she was an associate professor and director of study abroad at the College of Notre Dame of Maryland (now Notre Dame of Maryland University), Baltimore, and from 2002 to 2011 was the School Sisters of Notre Dame representative to the United Nations' Department of Public Information and the Economic and Social Council, New York. Since 2011 Sister Ann has been the associate director for social mission for the Leadership Conference of Women Religious, Silver Spring, Maryland.
