## Sister Dianne Marie Engelhart, SSND

*First Profession - July 15, 1972 | Celebrating 50 Years*



**Sister Dianne Marie Engelhart** was born in Watertown, Wisconsin, and in 1972 made first profession in Mequon, Wisconsin. In 1973 she received a bachelor's degree in English from Mount Mary College (now University), Milwaukee. She began her ministry teaching at Messmer High School, Milwaukee from 1973 to 1974. She then went to McDonell Central High School, Chippewa Falls, Wisconsin, where she taught until 1977. She came back to southeastern Wisconsin and worked in the printing department at Notre Dame of the Lake, Mequon. Having an aptitude for the work, she attended Milwaukee Area Technical College in 1979 and received a certificate in printing and graphics. After receiving her certification, Sister Dianne Marie resumed her ministry as printer for the School Sisters of Notre Dame, remaining in the role for 19 years. She then served at the Lutheran Home, Wauwatosa, Wisconsin, first as an office assistant from 1999 to 2003 and then as an employee services assistant from 2003 to 2013. Sister Dianne Marie is currently serving as an administrative assistant at St. Jude the Apostle, Wauwatosa.
