First Profession - July 15, 1972 | Celebrating 50 Years



Sister Eileen Ennis is a native of Milwaukee and in 1972 professed first vows at Mequon, Wisconsin. She received a bachelor's degree in mathematics and chemistry from Mount Mary College (now University), Milwaukee in 1973. After receiving her degree, Sister Eileen started her ministry at Messmer High School, Milwaukee, teaching there until 1976. She then went to St. Mary, Burlington, Wisconsin, where she taught until 1983. From 1983 to 1984 she taught at St. Mary's High School, New England, North Dakota. Upon her return to Wisconsin, she served as a graduate teaching assistant at Marquette University, Milwaukee, while earning a master's degree in mathematics, which she received in 1986. She then spent several years teaching at Mount Mary University and Marquette University. In 1993 Sister Eileen became the first congregational director of communications at the Generalate in Rome, serving in this role until 1998. After returning to Milwaukee, she was the interim dean of students at Mount Mary University for one semester before resuming her teaching position at Marquette University. She returned to the Generalate as coordinator of communications from 2001 to 2003. Since 2003 Sister Eileen has ministered as an instructor of practice
