## Sister Faith Wanner, SSND

*First Profession - August 17, 1972 | Celebrating 50 Years*



**Sister Faith Wanner** is originally from Dickinson, North Dakota, and in 1972 made first profession in Mankato, Minnesota. In 1973 she received a bachelor's degree in history from Mount Mary College (now University), Milwaukee and then taught at St. Francis de Sales, St. Paul, Minnesota, for two years. From St. Francis de Sales, Sister Faith went to St. Michael, St. Michael, Minnesota, teaching there until 1978 when she moved to Gilbertville, Iowa, and taught at Immaculate Conception Elementary School for one year. She then spent the next five years teaching at St. Mary's High School, New England, North Dakota. In 1984 she received a master's degree in library science from Spalding University, Louisville, Kentucky. After receiving her master's degree, Sister Faith served as a librarian at the Academy of the Holy Angels, Richfield, Minnesota, for three years. She then went to St. Mary's Central High School, Bismarck, North Dakota, where she was a librarian from 1987 to 2000 and an administrative assistant from 2000 to 2002. After earning an advanced library science degree online from the University of North Texas, Denton, Sister Faith served as librarian and head of technical services at Dickinson State University, Dickinson, North Dakota, for 11 years. Since 2014 she has been

in Fargo, North Dakota, where she has been a support staff member at Catholic Health Initiative Riverview Place, and currently is a test administrator at Pearson Professional Center.
