First Profession - June 18, 1972 | Celebrating 50 Years



Sister Joan Andert was born in St. Louis and made first profession there in 1972. She received a bachelor's degree in mathematics from the former Notre Dame College, St. Louis in 1973. During the early part of her ministry, Sister Joan taught at St. Joseph, East St. Louis, Illinois; Notre Dame High School, Cape Girardeau, Missouri; St. Paul High School, Highland, Illinois; and Quincy Notre Dame High School, Quincy, Illinois. She received a master's degree in mathematics from Southeast Missouri State University, Cape Girardeau, Missouri, in 1984. In 1987 Sister Joan arrived at Rosati-Kain High School, St. Louis, teaching until 1989 and then serving as the school's administrator and president until 2018. Since 2019 she has been serving as director of the ministry office for the School Sisters of Notre Dame Central Pacific Province, St. Louis.
