## Sister Kathleen Brice, SSND

*First Profession - June 11, 1972 | Celebrating 50 Years*



**Sister Kathleen Brice** is originally from St. Louis, and made first profession there in 1972. In 1973 she received a bachelor's degree in history from the former Notre Dame College, St. Louis. She spent the early years of her ministry teaching in schools located throughout the Midwest, including St. Joseph, East St. Louis, Illinois; Helias High School, Jefferson City, Missouri; Notre Dame High School, Burlington, Iowa; and Notre Dame High School, Cape Girardeau, Missouri, where she also served as campus minister. She received a master's degree in history from Creighton University, Omaha, Nebraska, in 1980. Since 1983 Sister Kathleen has ministered in St. Louis, teaching at Notre Dame High School, St. Joseph Academy and Ursuline Academy; and serving as assistant principal at Incarnate Word Academy. In 2016 Sister Kathleen returned to Notre Dame High School where she is still teaching today.
