Sister Lavonne Krebs is originally from New England, North Dakota, and in 1972 professed first vows in Mankato, Minnesota. After profession, she served as a clerical staff member at Our Lady of Good Counsel Academy, Mankato. She received a bachelor's degree in mathematics from Mount Mary College (now University), Milwaukee in 1974. Starting in 1975 Sister Lavonne spent the next 33 years teaching in Minnesota schools, including Shakopee Area Catholic School, Shakopee; and Winona Area Catholic School, Cotter Junior High School, and Cotter High School, all in Winona. In 2008 she went to Rome where she was engaged in community service at the Generalate for six years. After returning to the United States, Sister Lavonne was engaged in community service at Our Lady of Good Counsel, Mankato for one year and then was a member of the support staff at Catholic Health Initiative-Riverview, Fargo, North Dakota, from 2016 to 2019. Currently Sister Lavonne is serving as a volunteer throughout various locations in the School Sisters of Notre Dame Central Pacific Province.
