## Sister Margaret Mary Schmidt, SSND

*First Profession - June 11, 1972 | Celebrating 50 Years*



**Sister Margaret Mary Schmidt** was born in St. Louis and made first profession there in 1972. She received a bachelor's degree in English from the former Notre Dame College, St. Louis in 1973. Beginning that same year, she taught for the next 20 years at St. Francis de Sales High School, St. Louis; St. Francis Solanus, Quincy, Illinois; St. Mary, Alton, Illinois; St. Teresa, Belleville, Illinois; Notre Dame High School, Cape Girardeau, Missouri; and Our Lady of Lourdes, Washington, Missouri. In 1985 Sister Margaret Mary received a master's degree in religious studies from Mundelein College, Chicago. During the mid-1980s through the early 2000s, she taught at Notre Dame High School, Burlington, Iowa; served as administrator at St. Theresa of Avila, Salem, Illinois; taught at St. Peter Grade School, Jefferson City, Missouri; and was the administrator at St. Rose School, Desoto, Missouri. In 2003 Sister Margaret Mary spent two years teaching English to elementary and high school students in Kyoto, Japan, and then returned to serve as administrator at St. Theresa of Avila, Salem, Illinois, for seven years. From 2012 to 2014 she taught and served as principal at Immaculate Conception, Macon, Missouri, and from 2014 to 2018 taught and assisted in after school care at Sacred Heart

School, Troy, Missouri. Since 2018 Sister Margaret Mary has been a member of the community leadership team at Sancta Maria in Ripa, St. Louis.
