Sister Mary Ann Kuhn, SSND

First Profession - January 24, 1973 | Celebrating 50 Years



Sister Mary Ann Kuhn was born in Farmington, Minnesota, and in 1973 made first profession in Mankato, Minnesota. That same year, she received a bachelor's degree in music education from Mount Mary College (now University), Milwaukee and began her ministry teaching at Lonsdale-New Mark-Veseli School, Lonsdale, Minnesota. She remained in Lonsdale until 1981 and then went to St. John the Baptist, Savage, Minnesota. In 1983 she received a master's degree in spirituality from Creighton University, Omaha, Nebraska. Sister Mary Ann continued to teach at St. John the Baptist until 1984, going next to the Center for Spiritual Development, Bird Island, Minnesota, where she served as a staff member. She became the Center's administrator of the retreat house in 1989 and remained in that position until 1995 when she was selected to serve on the provincial council for the former Mankato Province. After serving as a councilor for eight years, Sister Mary Ann was engaged in parish ministry at several Minnesota parishes for the next 15 years, including St. Andrew, Fairfax; Sacred Heart, Franklin; St. Willibrord, Gibbon; and St. Francis de Sales, Winthrop. Since 2019 Sister Mary Ann has served as community leader at Our Lady of Good Counsel, Mankato.
