## Sister Genevieve Cassani, SSND

First Profession - July 30, 1962 | Celebrating 60 Years



**Sister Genevieve Cassani** was born in St. Louis and made first profession there in 1962. She received a bachelor's degree in art from the former Notre Dame College, St. Louis. That same year she began her ministry teaching at Sacred Heart, Valley Park, Missouri. She taught at Sacred Heart until 1966 and then went to the Academy of Notre Dame, Belleville, Illinois. In 1971 Sister Genevieve received a master's degree in art education from the University of Illinois Champagne-Urbana. After seven years at the Academy of Notre Dame, she served in initial formation for the former St. Louis Province for two years. From 1974 to 1984 Sister Genevieve was a spiritual and retreat director at the former Center for Spiritual Development in the former St. Louis Province. She spent a sabbatical year studying Spanish at the Mexican Cultural Center, San Antonio and studying Old Testament theology at Eden Seminary, Webster Groves, Missouri. Beginning in 1993 Sister Genevieve spent the next 14 years as the director of mission effectiveness for the former St. Louis Province. Since 2009 she has been serving through the Ministry of Art and Design, St. Louis.
