Sister Gloria Degele is originally from Dickinson, North Dakota, and in 1962 made first profession in Mankato, Minnesota. Beginning in 1964 Sister Gloria devoted her early ministry years to homemaking and housekeeping. She served at Our Lady of Good Counsel, Mankato, Minnesota; St. Agnes, St. Paul, Minnesota; St. Mary, New England, North Dakota; and St. Andrew, St. Paul. Beginning in 1976 Sister Gloria served as a beautician, first at Independent Services, Savage, Minnesota, until 1977 and then at St. Matthew, St. Paul until 1990. From 1990 to 1992 she studied textile arts at Minneapolis Technical College, Minneapolis and then was an upholsterer for Independent Services, Perham, Minnesota, from 1992 to 1995.
