### *A memory I have to share...*

I began baking when I started the doctoral program in physics at Oklahoma State University. In an effort to form community, I would gift fellow graduate students and faculty members with a baked treat to share with their friends on their birthdays.

**Sister Jeanette Feldott** is originally from Quincy, Illinois, and in 1962 made first profession in St. Louis. She received a bachelor's degree in mathematics from the former Notre Dame College, St. Louis in 1964. After receiving her degree Sister Jeanette began teaching at Althoff Catholic High School, Belleville, Illinois, where she remained for one year. From 1965 to 1973 she taught at St. Francis Borgia, Washington, Missouri. During this time she earned a master's degree in physical science with an emphasis in physics from Emporia State University, Emporia, Kansas. In 1973 she began her studies at Oklahoma State University, Stillwater, Oklahoma, and received a doctorate in physics in 1977. After finishing her doctoral studies, Sister Jeanette went to North Carolina where she was a research associate at the University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill. Beginning in 1980 she went to Marquette University, Milwaukee where she earned tenure, taught and was a researcher until 1989. After one year serving on the clerical staff at Johnson Controls, Milwaukee and while looking for another position, Sister Jeanette went to Oklahoma City where she served as a professor at the Oklahoma School of Science and Math until 2001. Toward the end of 2001 she went back to her hometown of Quincy. There she tutored students at Quincy Notre Dame High School in the areas of math, chemistry and physics until 2015 when she retired. She was later asked to remain at the school for another year in the same position. She also spent three years in the

early to mid-2000s teaching at John Wood Community College. From 2015 to 2020 Sister Jeanette also was a part-time proofreader and writer for Cambridge Educational Services, Des Plaines, Illinois. Since 2018 she has been serving in prayer and presence and currently resides at Veronica House, The Sarah Community, Bridgeton, Missouri.
