## Sister Juliette Daigle, SSND

First Profession - July 30, 1962 | Celebrating 60 Years



**Sister Juliette Daigle** is originally from New Orleans and in 1962 made first profession in St. Louis. She earned a bachelor's degree in economics from the former Notre Dame College, St. Louis in 1964. She began her ministry that same year, teaching at Immaculate Conception, Marrero, Louisiana, where she remained for two years. She then went to Sacred Heart High School, New Orleans where she taught until 1974. While she was teaching at Sacred Heart, she earned a master's degree in business education from the University of Central Arkansas, Conway, Arkansas. From 1974 to 1981 Sister Juliette taught at Carmel High School, Houston and from 1981 to 1991 at Seton Academy, New Orleans. From 1982 to 1987 she served as a member of the formation team for the former Dallas Province. Beginning in 1991 she taught for two years at Holy Cross High School, San Antonio and then served as secretary for the former Dallas Province until 2005. In 2006 Sister Juliette was called to Rome where she served as general secretary and archivist at the Generalate. Since 2015 Sister Juliette has been at Notre Dame of Dallas and currently serves as an administrative assistant.
