**Sister Karl Mary Winkelmann** is originally from St. Louis and made first profession there in 1962. In 1964 she received a bachelor's degree in English from the former Notre Dame College, St. Louis. From 1964 to 1970 she taught at Rosary High School, St. Louis and then served as administrator from 1970 to 1978 at Notre Dame High School, Quincy, Illinois. While at Notre Dame High School she received a master's degree in secondary education administration from Southern Illinois University-Edwardsville. From 1978 to 1996 and from 2000 to 2003, she was administrator at Rosary High School, St. Louis; between her terms as administrator, she served as associate superintendent for the Catholic Education Office, St. Louis. Beginning in 2003 Sister Karl Mary served for 15 years as president of Trinity Catholic High School, St. Louis. After retiring from Trinity Catholic High School in 2018, Sister Karl Mary joined the staff of St. Frances Cabrini Academy where she served for two years in donor solicitation. Currently she volunteers at the St. Augustine Wellston Center, which provides outreach to the poor and underserved in North St. Louis County.
